Club Competitions

Outdoor Season

Porter Nominated

Round: National

For: Anyone

The Winner Is: The archer whose initial Pre-shoot estimate of their score comes closest to what he/she scores.

Special Rules: Archers of any Bowman classification are not allowed to miss with their last six arrows. Other archers may miss with one except their last, and longbow archers can miss two (except their last).

Club Shield

Round: Windsor or Albion (rotate annually)

For: Anyone who can shoot the round.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted score.

Ray Bent



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Round: 3 x six dozen rounds (legs) shot throughout the outdoor season. A mixture of Imperial and Metric rounds.

For: Anyone who shoots all three legs of the season.

The Winner Is: The archer who scores the highest Handicap Adjusted scores of all three legs combined.

Presidents Cup

Round: York or Hereford (rotate annually)

For: Anyone who can shoot the round.

The Winner Is: He or she who makes the highest made score. No Handicaps.

Round: National

For: Competitors who shoot Longbow or American Flat Bow. No Recurve or Bare bows allowed.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted score.

Novice & Veterans

Round: National or Short Metric. (Rotate annually)

For: Novice --- Archers in their **FIRST FULL** outdoor season.

Veterans --- Archers 55 or over on the day of the shoot.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted score. It is possible for the same person to win both.

Club Challenge

Round: Windsor or Albion (rotate annually)

For: Anyone who can shoot the round.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted score.

Jim Norris Frostbite Series

Round: Frostbite

For: Anyone who shoots at least four of the rounds over the season.

The Winner Is: Jim Norris Frostbite – Archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted Score.

Jim Norris Open – Archer with the highest made score.



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Outdoor Pairs

Round: Frostbite

For: Anyone who shoots at least four rounds over the season.

The winners are: The score of archer with the highest made score is added to the archer with the lowest made score; the score of the archer with the second highest score is added to the score of the second lowest and so on. The winners are the highest combined scores.

Indoor Season

The indoor season competitions are shot on a Tuesday and Friday evening. An archer shooting on a Tuesday must state before starting to shoot if he/she is taking part in the competition that night. An archer CAN NOT shoot two rounds and submit their best score.

Chairman's Plate

Round: Portsmouth.

For: Any archer who shoots the round.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest made score.

Captains Cup

Round: Portsmouth.

For: Any archer who shoots the round.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted score.

Vegas

Round: Vegas.

For: Any archer who shoots the round.

The Winner Is: The archer with the highest Handicap Adjusted Score.

Indoor Pairs

Round: 2 dozen arrows shot from 12 yards at a 40cm face.

For: Any archer who shoots at least four separate rounds.

The Winner Is: The same principle as the Outdoor Pairs above.
